• Call to Order

• Financial Report

Receipts: \$60,962. Disbursements: \$55,569 including rent of \$7,900. Difference: \$5,393 (note positive). It is looking like we will end the year within budget.

Reflection on Mission, Vision & Core Values

• Stewardship Campaign

Chuck provided an update. We now have 90 statements of intent. Last year, we were at 101 in early January. The dollars in the pledges are very encouraging. Generally, we've had a good stewardship drive.

Budget

With what we had received with statements of intent last week and estimating those who had not pledged, we still have a variance of about \$78,000 to the negative. We continue to look for ways to address the deficit. We are looking at a 2% raise to the staff – this is the first raise in 5 years. Pastor Chuck would not be at synod minimums. Pastor Bridget would be. Janene is wondering what we can do to help increase the giving. We are at double the loss that we were at last year. We will need to do some follow-on campaigns. Our goal is to increase giving pledges by at least \$40,000.

• New Council Members

We have potential council members: Shannon Spicciati and Ryan Monsen. We are still looking for a treasurer as well as another council nominee. We need a total of three nominees plus a candidate for treasurer.

• Staff Expectations for Ending and Re-entering

Chuck is still looking for social media language. He is recommending that we adopt the policy as is and then come back and amend it. This information will be shared with the congregation through both the pulpit as well as written copies. Chuck moved that we adopt the policy as written. (Harris / Nelson) Motion passed.

• Annual Meeting

Looking at the calendar, the week for the annual meeting would be February 5. Motion to se the date for February 5. (McLaughlin/Radabaugh) Motion passed.

• Constitution Review

Josh provided a red-lined copy of the constitution with the recommended changes by the ELCA and synod. Motion to approve changes as presented to take to the congregation at the annual meeting. (Radabaugh / McLaughlin) Motion passed.

Faith Formation

We need some additional support for Bridget for Faith Formation. There is sign up sheets in the back of the church. Please help identify individuals and invite them to participate in faith formations. We need help leading faith in action classes, mentoring faith in action students, and helping planning faith foundation activities.
